Students may petition to waive their third tutorial if they meet certain conditions. Waivers of the third tutorial require that the student:

 Has chosen an advisor with sufficient funding to support the student when GSBS funding ends.

AND

• Has extensive previous research experience, a thesis-based MS degree and/or publications in the biomedical sciences.

Students who meet at least one of these criteria and wish to waive their third tutorial should complete this form and send it to **gsbs.phd.advising@uth.tmc.edu** and copy their new advisor on their e-mail to request the waiver.

Please note that the waiver of more than one tutorial is very unusual and would require additional justification. It is understandable that students are eager to get started on their dissertation research and may choose to waive the third tutorial, if they're eligible. However, before taking that step, students should consider the benefits of doing a third tutorial:

- Exposure to a new area of science.
- Opportunities to learn new approaches and methodologies.
- Development of relationships with other researchers who may offer opportunities for future networking, become members of the student's Advisory Committee, and/or authors of future recommendation letters.
