Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can the travel award be used for offsite courses and workshops?

Yes, the travel award will cover offsite courses and workshops.

2. Can the travel award be combined with other awards to help defray the cost of travel?

Yes, the travel award can be combined with other awards. Travel award applicants should also consider applying for the <u>GSBS</u> travel award.

3. Is the travel award competitive (i.e. are all applying students competing for one single award)?

The travel award is not competitive.

4. How much is awarded to the student?

Travel award recipients will receive a \$750 travel award. Typically, the travel award is awarded as a reimbursement for up to \$750 in travel expenses.

5. Is there a deadline to apply for this award?

Typically, you should submit your application, following the steps outlined in number 6, soon after receiving your acceptance letter. The program should be notified at least 60 days prior to travel.

6. How do I apply for the travel award?

To apply for the travel award, you will need to email Dr. Wenzel a copy of your submitted abstract and conference acceptance letter, along with a brief statement describing your travel (conference name, date, location). You should also Cc your advisor/mentor, Dr. Zal and Teasha Barker. Please make sure that your advisor is aware that the travel award will only cover up to \$750 of your travel; as remaining expenses are usually covered by the lab/advisor.
