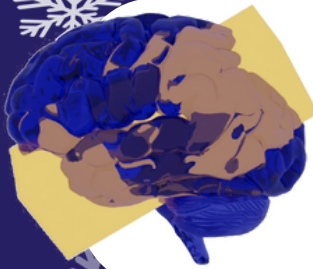



Hope everyone has had a good month. Rodrigo and I wanted to thank all the students for attending the program meeting. We enjoyed the lively discussion and the opportunity to hear your thoughts on various aspects of the proposal. I would like to touch base with all of you with respect to the student awards. As you remember, we had originally proposed to have two awards, both made to post-candidacy students. In response to your input, we have modified this strategy, and now propose to confer only one award to post-candidacy students and another to pre-candidacy/Master's students. Budget permitting, the former will be for \$2000 per award and the latter will be \$1000 per award. Pending approval by the faculty members in the steering committee, we will make the official announcement and commence with the nomination process.
