





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## KARTIK'S KORNER

Dear all,

Hope everyone is having a good year so far. I wanted to take this opportunity to announce that the neuroscience program will be moving to the <a href="chalk-talk-format-for-candidacy-exams">chalk-format-for-candidacy-exams</a> from Spring 2026 onwards. There is strong consensus among the program faculty that this format would be the most



effective in highlighting the students' grasp of their research project. The format has been very popular among both students and faculty of the Genetics and Epigenetics (G&E) program.

Understandably, many of you are unsure about the format of the new exam. The program will be introducing several new initiatives to make this transition smoother.

**First**, students and faculty from the G&E program would be providing us with a short information session regarding the utility and efficacy of this format. This event has been currently scheduled for late March 2025.

**Second**, we will conduct a mock chalk talk during the program retreat in May. I will be the presenter and will be "examined" by other attending neuroscience faculty. This will be an opportunity for all of you to observe a chalk talk in action.

**Third**, starting from the fall 2025 semester, some of the WIP slots will be allotted for chalk talk practice. The first of these sessions would include a session where faculty would provide instructions on how best to structure your chalk talk. Additionally, a few faculty and I will be available for 1 hour practice chalk talks, if students would rather do this in a less public forum.

We are hopeful that these changes will aid in your development as articulate and independent investigators. If you have other specific suggestions, please feel free to email me.
